1. Apologies

2. Declarations of Interest

There were none.

3. Minutes of the last Meeting: 13 October 2010

Following the addition of Myran Eade on the attendance list and the change of the word 'not' to 'now' on the last line of the second paragraph under the section 'Streetlighting', it was agreed that the minutes of the last meeting held on 13 October 2010 having been circulated, be approved, adopted and signed as a correct record.

4. Matters Arising

- **Speedwatch Framfield**. The Clerk reported that as detailed at the recent PC meeting, as no action was to be taken by ESCC or the Police, the campaigners deemed any further action pointless so Speedwatch was sadly, for the time-being, in abeyance.
- **Streetlighting** the Clerk reported that the order had been placed with ESCC to replace all the lights (excluding four) in Blackboys with the fluorescent bulbs. Framfield would be completed in the next financial year.
- **Guideposts** The Clerk reported that she has made contact with Phil Anderson but he has not done the work requested. She would have a further attempt.
- Community Action Plan Felicity Groves reported that she still had to meet with the Clerk and any other members who could have input into the Plan.

5. Any Other Business

- Bus Shelter opposite the Blackboys Inn. The Clerk was asked to obtain a quote from the handyman for its removal as it is in need of repair and actually isn't serviced by any buses!
- Dog bins. As requested by Bernard Lillywhite at the full PC meeting, consideration was given to removing one bin from Framfield recreation ground as a budgetary exercise. Ironically, the Clerk had received a telephone request that day from the resident who very kindly empties the litter bin on the play area on Blackboys recreation ground asking for the reinstatement of the second bin as people are filling up the litter bin with dog waste! The meeting agreed that for the present time both bins would be kept on Framfield and the Clerk was asked to put signs up in Blackboys asking people not to use the litter bin for dog waste.
