The Parish Council supports the application which are sympathetic improvements to enhance the property using a excellent designs. Would it be possible to impose a condition restricting the colours applied to the wood (no bright colours)?

 WD/2019/0076/O – Outline application for the erection of 4 no. new build dwellings.
 Squires Farm Industrial Estate, Palehouse Common, Framfield TN22 5RB.

The Parish Council objects to the application even though it is quite detailed and well thought through. The site is wholly unsuitable for the construction of residential dwellings and with the existing houses squeezed in on the end of the estate already and then these too, it is as though the owners are trying to build a new estate in a piecemeal fashion. The argument made in relation to the suitability of the site for residential buildings [e.g. "The site is relatively close to a bus route"; "The local terrain makes cycling an attractive option"; "A regular train service is available"] to be far-fetched and unconvincing. It is not a good area for anyone to live, with no amenities and no bus stop nearby therefore being reliant on their own transport.
