The following decisions were made under delegated authority by Maria Naylor (Chairman), Trishia Blewitt and David Jenner. (The Chairman has the casting vote in any tie).

- **WD/2023/2997/F – Proposed Porch.
Dappledown Barn, Pound Lane, Framfield, East Sussex TN22 5RR.**

The Parish Council supports the application which is in keeping with the character of the property and would be an improvement.

- **WD/2024/0262/F - Erection of single storey side extension.
Larks, Bird in Eye Hill, Framfield, East Sussex TN22 5HA.**

The Parish Council supports the application which makes good use of the original car port area.

- **WD/2024/0199/F – Single storey side extension.
Oakleigh Cottage, Eastbourne Road, Uckfield.**

The Parish Council supports the application and although notes the concerns of the neighbours, does not believe the windows will have a detrimental effect as one is a bathroom and the other at high level.

- **WD/2024/0256/F & 0257/LB – The erection of a catslide extension and glazed link.
Tickerage Mill Barn, Pound Lane, Framfield, East Sussex TN22 5RU.**

The Parish Council supports the application. The original circular design was rejected by WDC but the applicant has worked with WDC to change the plans to a catslide extension with a glazed connecting link. Seemingly, a catslide roof was in place in the past. Subject to any comments from the Conservation Officer.

- **WD/2024/0306/F – Two-storey extension to existing dwelling and detached single storey garage.
Weald View, Pound Lane, Framfield, East Sussex TN22 5RR.**

The Parish Council supports the application. The extension fits in well with the new build house and will not have a detrimental effect on the neighbouring properties. As an aside, is the proposed East elevation mixed up with the South?
